Here is how the program works:

- The Antique Boats Center's Service team will perform a detailed 12-point engine/mechanical and marine/hull inspection of the boat

Engine/Mechanical includes review of:

Inspection of Engine/Running Gear
Inspection of Fuel System
Inspection of Lubrication System
Inspection of Electrical System
Inspection of Cooling System
Inspection of Trailer

Marine/Hull includes review of:

Check Visible Frames/Chine/Keel
Bottom
Hull Side
Decks
Finish
Safety

- If any items require service to be water-ready, Antique Boat Center will provide a detailed cost estimate for the work to be performed.
- Once all recommended repairs and/or replacements have been made, Antique Boat Center will then conduct a water test.
- Once the boat has passed all of the above inspections, recommended repairs have been made and a satisfactory water test performed, Antique Boat Center will designate the boat – **Water-Ready Certified**. A **Water-Ready Certified** report will be provided to the buyer at time of purchase. Any items repaired or replaced by the Antique Boat Center as part of the inspection will carry a 1-year warranty from Antique Boat Center from the time of purchase to the buyer.
- Antique Boat Center will prominently feature **Water-Ready Certified** boats on its website and in the showroom.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The Pre-Sale 12-point inspection and water test costs \$925.00. The seller will receive a detailed report identifying the current condition of the boat. A boat must pass all 12-point inspections and the water test to be designated – **Water-Ready Certified**.
- The inspection is valid for 6-month intervals. If the boat has not been sold in 6 months, Antique Boat Center will perform re-inspections. Re-inspections are performed at NO CHARGE to the seller.
- If new issues arise from the re-inspection, Antique Boat Center will provide the seller with a detailed cost estimate for the required work to be performed.
- A boat must continue to pass all 12-inspection points to retain the **Water-Ready Certification** designation.
